COVID – 19 Impacts Elmvale Community Arena – January 24, 2021

On January 20, the Government of Ontario announced the plans to gradually ease public health restrictions effective January 31, 2022 at 12:01 a.m. Ontario will begin the process of gradually easing restrictions, while maintaining protective measures, including but not limited to:

50% Capacity Limits: The Elmvale Arena will have limited capacities in all areas to accommodate the required regulations and physical distancing measures.

Entry & Exit: Groups can check into the arena a maximum of 30 minutes prior to their ice time. Following each ice time participants, spectators and coaches will have 20 minutes to change and vacate the building. Please be respectful of this time so the next groups can enter without delay.

Dressing Rooms Capacities: Dressing room capacities will be limited to 10 participants per room. Each team will be assigned two dressing rooms for their team to get ready prior to their ice time. Coaches and team managers may have to schedule and monitor the rotation of players through their designated dressing rooms. Showers will be CLOSED in all dressing rooms. Officials, coaches & volunteers are not included in those numbers.

Participants are encouraged to arrive partially dressed to limit the time in the dressing rooms.

Face Coverings: A face covering that fully covers the mouth and nose continues to be required in all areas of an indoor recreation facility. It is imperative that masks are worn in the dressing room and only removed directly before participants are putting helmets on and heading to the ice surface. This is to be monitored and enforced by coaches and team managers.

Spectators: Spectators will be limited to a maximum of <u>2</u> spectators/guardians per participant. Spectators will be granted entry with the participants/players at the beginning of the ice booking. Once you have entered the building, you must remain for the scheduled ice time. All spectator viewing will be in the bleachers (cold section) of the arena. All patrons are asked to quickly vacate the building after your ice time to ensure total building capacity limits are maintained and to allow staff time to clean. Food and drink will not be permitted in the arena and the concession booth will be closed.

Hallways in Motion: The main entry way and lobby will be signed "Hallsways in Motion" to ensure proper physical distancing. Please ensure no stopping, congregating and/or viewing in the main lobby and entry way.

Physical Distancing: Physical/social distancing is required in lineups both inside and outside of the facility, as well as throughout the arena.

Proof of Vaccination - QR Code: All persons 12 years of age and older will be required to provide the enhanced QR code Proof of Vaccination or Medical Exemptions along with valid ID prior to entry. Entrance will not be permitted without the QR code version of the Proof of Vaccination (POV) or Medical Exemption. Enhanced QR code Proof of Vaccination will be accepted in digital or paper (print) form. You can download your enhanced certificate with QR code by visiting covid-19.ontario.ca/get-proof/

Acceptable forms of ID must show the person's name and birth. Examples include:

- * Driver's License
- * Health Card
- * Passport

Digital forms of ID are no longer able to be accepted (ie. pictures on your smartphone, photocopies, etc.). It must be the actual piece of identification (youth aged 12-18 years old are exempt from this and they may show a digital version of their ID). Please note, children who are under 12 but look older, may also be required to provide ID to confirm proof of age.

Contact Tracing & Screening: All visitors (participants & spectators) must complete a health screening prior to entering the building for each ice time. The online COVID-19 Active Screening form can be filled out at the following link: https://forms.springwater.ca/Forms/visitor

Please ensure the online COVID-19 self-screening is completed prior to arrival. If you are feeling ill or answer YES to any screening questions prior to arriving at the arena, please do not attend.

For those without a cell phone/computer, an alternative will be provided to you at the door. Screenings must be completed the day of your visit.
